Pitching in to clean up Lane Cove National Park

Frasers Property volunteers look forward to Clean Up Australia Day

Sydney – 16 February 2017 – Around 50 volunteers from Frasers Property Australia will roll up their sleeves at Lane Cove National Park to help beautify one of Sydney's natural jewels for Business Clean Up Australia Day on Tuesday February 28.

From 9am to 2pm, the volunteers will join local conservation group Friends of Lane Cove National Park (LCNP) and park rangers to remove rubbish along the Lane Cove River, including an old glass bottle dumping ground.

Volunteers will also be flexing their muscles to remove the giant *Arundo donax* reed that has unfortunately encroached on the park in recent times.

Lane Cove National Park is near Frasers Property's Centrale community in North Ryde and as such was a natural focus when it came to this year's Clean Up Australia Day, says Olivia Leal-Walker, Sustainability Coordinator, Frasers Property Australia.
